Providers of goods or services referred to herein, constitute suppliers of the contest organizer and are not involved in any capacity whatsoever in the organization of this contest.

**Article 2: CONTEST ENTRY**

The contest can only be accessed via following mini-site <https://welcomea350.ca/>. The rules to participate are described in Article 4.

The contest is open to Ontario residents, ages 18 and over.

Directors, officers and employees of KLM and Air France, as well as their immediate families are not eligible to participate. As well any person having participated, directly or indirectly, in the elaboration and the implemented of this contest, as well as his(her) immediate family are not eligible to participate.

Participation in the contest supposes unreserved acceptance of the present rules and all their provisions, as well as of all laws and regulations applicable to free contests.

Failure to abide by the conditions set forth in these rules will result in the automatic disqualification of the entrant.

Any attempt to disrupt the normal operation of this contest may result in the immediate elimination of the person involved.

#### **Article 5: ENTRIES ALLOWED**
